The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 21, 2009, 38th Street Solar System (38th Street), 20th Street Solar System (20th Street), and Cameron Street Solar System (Cameron Street) filed applications for certification as eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facilities. On December 22, 2009, Garrod Hydraulics Solar System (Garrod) and La Maison Solar System (La Maison) also filed applications for certification as eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facilities.
- (2) As additional information and investigation was necessary in order to thoroughly review these applications, these

applications were suspended by entry issued on February 18, 2010, in accordance with Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code. Commission Staff subsequently contacted the applicants, notifying them of the reasons for the suspension and directing the applicants to provide additional information.

(3) Despite Staff's requests, applicants have not supplied the information necessary to complete the review of these applications. Accordingly, applicants are directed to provide responses to all outstanding information requests made by Staff by March 11, 2011. The failure by any applicant to provide the requested information by that date will result in a recommendation by the attorney examiner that the Commission deny that party's application.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That 38th Street, 20th Street, Cameron Street, Garrod, and La Maison provide responses to all outstanding information requests made by Staff by March 11, 2011. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in these cases.
