**AMENDED PETITION OF
CINCINNATI BELL EXTENDED TERRITORIES LLC
FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF THE POOLING ADMINISTRATOR**

On January 31, 2011, Cincinnati Bell Extended Territories LLC (“CBET”) filed a petition with the Commission requesting a review of a decision of the number Pooling Administrator (“PA”) which denied a CBET request for numbering resources. In that petition, CBET requested that the Commission authorize the Pooling Administrator to grant CBET’s application for a full NXX to fulfill a customer request. After consultation with the customer, CBET hereby amends its request. Specifically, rather than a full NXX, CBET now requests nine thousands-blocks in the Springfield rate center to meet its customer’s needs.

Upon review of the thousands-blocks available in the Springfield rate center pool, CBET finds that 9,000 consecutive numbers are available in the 937-523 NXX. CBET’s customer, Community Mercy Health Partners (“CMHP”) originally requested 10,000 numbers to meet its immediate needs and future growth. However, CMHP now believes that the 9,000 numbers available in the 937-523 NXX will satisfy its needs for the foreseeable future. Accordingly, CBET amends its Petition to request that the Commission authorize the PA to assign the nine thousands-blocks remaining in the 937-523 NXX to CBET to satisfy CMHP’s need for numbering resources. This amended

request will result in a more efficient use of numbering resources because it will enable the PA to assign CBET numbers currently available in the number pool and avoid having to open a new NXX.

For the reasons set forth above, CBET requests that the Commission expeditiously approve this amended request and direct the PA to grant CBET's request for nine thousands-blocks from the 937-523 NXX in the Springfield rate center to satisfy the needs of its customer.
