The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 24, 2011, the attorney examiner issued an entry in this case that directed the complainant, Mark Drake, to file by no later than February 8, 2011, a clear and concise statement of the facts underlying the complaint, including the service or services at issue. The entry indicated that if the complainant did not file such a statement by that date, the attorney examiner would recommend to the Commission that the complaint be dismissed.
- (2) On February 8, 2011, the complainant called the attorney examiner for the purpose of seeking an extension of time for filing the statement of facts due on February 8, 2011. However, the attorney examiner was unavailable at that time and, in fact, was unable until February 14, 2011, to discuss with complainant the matter of extending the deadline for the filing of the statement of facts.
- (3) On February 14, 2011, the attorney examiner discussed with both parties to the case by telephone the complainant's request for time extension. It was agreed among the parties and the attorney examiner that the complainant should be granted an extension, until Friday, February 18, 2011, to file the statement of facts originally called for by the attorney examiner January 24, 2011, entry in this case.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the complainant shall be granted an extension of time, until February 18, 2011, for filing the statement of the facts required under the attorney examiner's January 24, 2011, entry in this case. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in this case.
