The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Nolker Trucking LLC (respondent), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On November 17, 2010, respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) By entry of December 27, 2010, this matter was scheduled for an evidentiary hearing on February 22, 2011.
- (4) On February 18, 2011, staff filed a motion for a continuance. In support of its request, staff states that the parties need additional time to discuss a resolution of this matter. Therefore, the attorney examiner finds that the evidentiary hearing should be continued.
