The PUCO Motor Carrier Intrastate Regulations would have a very detrimental effect on my ability to continue to do business in Ohio. The cost of providing medical cards, medical examinations, paperwork involved with logbooks and driver's history reports, as well as pre and post trip inspection reports would be a drain on my limited resources, both financial and time related.

In a small business, like the one I operate, the owner wears many hats...bookkeeper, mechanic, inventory control and ordering, maintenance, human resources, promotional, etc...I do it all. These new regulations will limit my ability to be efficient in the operation of my business.

To add to the pain of this new law, I am of the understanding that government vehicles will be exempt. How totally unfair.

Seasonal companies like mine carry no hazardous materials and drive from fair to fair on one day each week. My vehicles travel less than 2000 miles each year and I feel it is unfair to subject me to the same regulations that are applied to the commercial trucking industry.
