<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 20, 2010, the Ohio State Legislative Board, United Transportation Union (UTU) filed a complaint against CSX Transportation (CSX) alleging that CSX permitted unsafe and hazardous walking and tripping conditions to exist at its facilities.
- (2) On November 29, 2010, CSX filed an answer to the complaint.
- (3) On December 14, 2010, staff filed an investigative report on the complaint that identified corrective action to be taken by CSX and recommended the complaint be held in abeyance for 30 days. On January 26, 2011, staff filed a follow-up report on the complaint indicating that the conditions giving rise to the complaint had been eliminated. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the complaint be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on all parties of record.
