ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 9, 2010, Lake Village Club, Inc. (Lake Village) filed a complaint against Camplands Water LLC (Camplands). Lake Village alleged in the complaint that it is a campground facility and that it is a customer of Camplands. Lake Village asserted in its complaint that Camplands' rates are unjust, unreasonable, unjustly preferential, and discriminatory, and that it provides inadequate service.
- (2) Camplands filed an answer to the complaint on October 28, 2010.
- (3) The attorney examiner issued an entry on January 5, 2011, scheduling this matter for a settlement conference.
- (4) Pursuant to the attorney examiner's entry, the parties convened for a settlement conference on January 20, 2011.
- (5) On January 27, 2011, Lake Village filed a motion to dismiss without prejudice. Lake Village explains that even though the parties have not settled the issues they will continue to negotiate without further involvement by the Commission.
- (6) Lake Village's motion to dismiss is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with Finding (6), the complaint filed by Lake Village be dismissed without prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
