The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On February 16, 2011, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling a March 31, 2011, hearing in this matter.
- (2) On March 23, 2011, staff filed a motion for a continuance of the hearing. Staff explained that the parties have had settlement discussions and need additional time to resolve matters. Staff adds that Respondent has indicated that he cannot be present on March 31, 2011, and agrees that a continuance would be beneficial. ORDERED, That the motion for continuance be granted until a date to be indicated in a future entry. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
