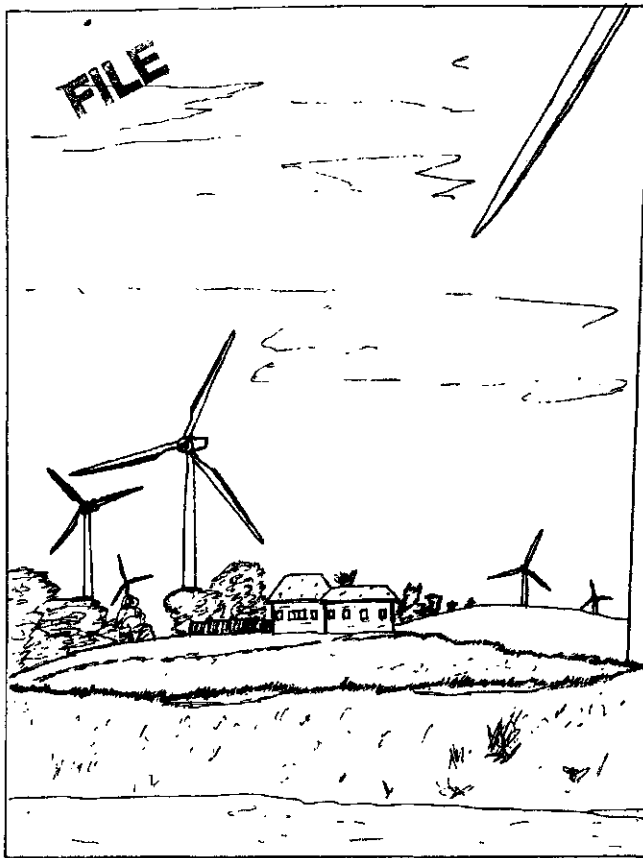

GREETINGS,

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1. BUY THE TURBINES FROM AN AMERICAN MANUFACTURER
2. DO NOT USE FUTURE TAXPAYER MONEY FUNDED BY DEBT TO CHINA TO FINANCE WIND INSTALLATIONS.
3. UTILIZE MANUFACTURER RECOMMENDED TURBINE SETBACKS FROM YOUR NON-PARTICIPANT NEIGHBORS' PROPERTY LINE, RATHER THAN RESIDENCE.
4. OFFER NEIGHBORS PROPERTY VALUE GUARANTEES.

7. SHARE THE INCOME FROM RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS, CARBON OFFSETS, TAX CREDITS, AND OTHER REVENUE STREAMS WITH YOUR PARTNER, THE LANDOWNER.
8. PUT ONE ON YOUR PROPERTY, AND PAY FOR IT YOURSELF.

IF THE WRITER SINCERELY BELIEVES THAT WE ARE NOT PAYING THE FULL COST OF COAL GENERATION, HIS TIME IS WELL SPENT ALERTING THE PUBLIC TO THOSE COSTS, AND CREATING SYSTEMS TO ADDRESS THEM. BUT TO OFFER A TECHNOLOGY WITH PROVEN ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL FAILURES WORLDWIDE AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR OUR

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SYSTEMS THAT WORK, AND FUNDING IT WITH
DEBT UPON FUTURE GENERATIONS WILL NOT SOLVE
THE STATED UNDERLYING PROBLEM.
