<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On December 21, 2009, 38th Street Solar System (38th Street) and Cameron Street Solar System (Cameron Street) filed applications for certification as eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facilities.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C), provides for automatic approval of an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility unless the Commission suspends the application within sixty days. The applications filed by 38th Street and Cameron Street were suspended by entry issued on February 18, 2010.
- (3) On March 28, 2011, 38th Street and Cameron Street filed requests to withdraw their applications.
- (4) The Commission finds that, based on the parties' requests to withdraw their applications, the applications filed by 38th Street and Cameron Street should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the applications filed by 38th Street and Cameron Street be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
