

IV. Description and Rationale for Transaction, including Public Interest Considerations

A. Introduction

On December 8, 2010, NTELOS Holdings Corp. ("NTELOS Holdings"), a Delaware Corporation, announced that it would split its wireline and wireless businesses into two separate and independent, publicly-traded companies. The current NTELOS publicly-traded company, NTELOS Holdings Corp., will become the wireless company. In preparation for the separation, NTELOS Holdings has formed two new companies, NTELOS Wireline One Inc. ("Wireline One") and NTELOS Wireline Two Inc. ("Wireline Two"). Following the completion of certain intermediate reorganization steps, Wireline Two will be a direct, wholly-owned subsidiary of Wireline One. Wireline Two will directly or indirectly own NTELOS' certificated competitive local exchange carriers and its incumbent local exchange carriers, including FiberNet of Ohio, LLC. The stock of Wireline One (and thus the ownership of the wireline business) will be distributed on a tax-free basis to NTELOS Holdings' shareholders. This petition is being filed with the Commission to seek its authority to transfer control of the NTELOS subsidiary regulated by and operating in the State of Ohio – FiberNet of Ohio, LLC – from NTELOS Holdings to the new Wireline One.

B. Description of the Parties

FiberNet of Ohio, LLC, is headquartered in Charleston, West Virginia, and is a PUCO regulated Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) operating in Ohio pursuant to PUCO Certificate No. 90-9201. FiberNet of Ohio, LLC is a wholly-owned subsidiary of NTELOS FiberNet Inc., which in turn is a wholly-owned subsidiary of NTELOS Inc., which in turn is a wholly-owned subsidiary of NTELOS Holdings Corp., a Delaware corporation. NTELOS

Holdings and NTELOS Inc. are also the owners of various other wireless and wireline businesses located in Virginia, West Virginia, Maryland, Pennsylvania and Kentucky. See existing organization chart attached hereto in Section E.

FiberNet of Ohio, LLC hereby respectfully seeks all requisite authority and necessary Commission approvals under Ohio Adm. Code § 4901:1-6-29 for the transfer of control of its operations to the new publicly traded company Wireline One Inc. pursuant to the separation of NTELOS Holdings' wireline and wireless operations, as explained in greater detail herein.

C. Rationale for the Transaction

The present structure of the NTLEOS family of corporations is shown on Exhibit A in Section E. NTELOS Holdings is a Delaware corporation that owns 100% of the equity of NTELOS Inc. NTELOS Inc. is a Virginia business corporation headquartered in Waynesboro, Virginia. NTELOS Inc., directly or indirectly, owns 100% of numerous wireless and wireline subsidiaries as shown on Exhibit A, Section E, including NTELOS FiberNet Inc., which is the 100% owner of FiberNet of Ohio, LLC.

FiberNet of Ohio, LLC is a wireline business duly authorized by the PUCO to provide CLEC services in Ohio pursuant to PUCO Certificate No. 90-9201. The Commission approved a

change in control of FiberNet of Ohio, LLC from One Communications Corp. to NTELOS Inc. by Order in PUCO Case No. 10-1063-TP-ACO.

As indicated above, on December 7, 2010, NTELOS Holdings' board of directors approved a proposed plan to create separate publicly traded wireless and wireline businesses by spinning off the wireline businesses owned by NTELOS Holdings and its various subsidiaries. To that end, a new family of wireline corporations has been created under the parent Wireline One. The structures of the Wireline One and NTELOS Holdings families of corporations are parallel, as shown in Section E, Exhibit B. Wireline One (a wireline company) is set up to parallel NTELOS Holdings (a wireless company). A second new company, Wireline Two, was incorporated to parallel NTELOS Inc. As with NTELOS Holdings, which owns 100% of NTELOS Inc., Wireline One will own 100% of the shares in Wireline Two following the completion of the internal restructuring.

With the launch of CLEC services in 1998, the wireline companies expanded into regional providers of transport, internet protocol-based ("IP") services, video, voice and data services. Certain of the wireline companies hold certificates as a CLEC in Virginia, West Virginia, Kentucky, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Maryland. As of December 31, 2010, the wireline companies had approximately 134,000 CLEC access lines, in more than 30 markets. The heart of the wireline companies' business is an extensive 5,700 route-mile fiber optic network used to backhaul communications traffic for retail services, to serve as a carriers' carrier network, and to provide transport services to third parties for long distance, internet, wireless and private network services. The wireline companies offer customers leading edge technology services, including Metro Ethernet and IP services.

NTELOS Inc. subsidiaries also hold PCS (wireless) licenses to operate in twenty-nine basic trading areas with a total licensed population of approximately 9.0 million. The wireless subsidiaries have built out network facilities in 22 of those basic trading areas. This network provides coverage to approximately 5.8 million people (also referred to as "POPS"). NTELOS Inc. wireless subsidiaries now serve over 432,000 retail wireless subscribers representing approximately 8% penetration of NTELOS Inc.'s total covered POPS. All of these wireless operations and licenses will remain within NTELOS Holdings following the separation.

The primary rationale for the separation is that separating wireless and wireline businesses will allow both the NTELOS Holdings and the Wireline One families of corporations to focus on their respective strengths – wireless and wireline operations – which will be to the ultimate benefit of consumers and stockholders alike.

D. Public Interest Considerations

1. The Transaction is in the Public Interest

The transaction described herein will serve the public interest. The telecommunications industry has been and continues to be subject to rapid technological advances, evolving consumer preferences and dynamic changes. Separating wireless and wireline operations into separate companies will allow each company to better serve its customers and to respond to the unique issues of their respective business models. FiberNet of Ohio, LLC expects that the transaction will enable it to strengthen its competitive position to the benefit of customers and the telecommunications marketplace.

2. The Transaction Will be Transparent to Customers

The transaction will be transparent to customers as they will not experience any change in their service, rates, or terms and conditions of such service. FiberNet of Ohio, LLC will continue to operate under its PUCO approved tariffs and the name of the operating company will be unchanged at this time. Any future changes to rates, terms or conditions, or other regulated pursuits will be made in accordance with PUCO requirements.


Because this transaction will be completely transparent to FiberNet of Ohio, LLC's customers, no notice to customers is required pursuant to Ohio Admin. Code § 4901:1-6-07.

3. The Transaction Poses no Competitive Risk

The transaction will not result in harm to competition in any relevant market, but rather, will yield tangible public interest benefits. The transaction should enhance competition by allowing Wireline One and its subsidiary, FiberNet of Ohio, LLC, to better compete with other wireline operators, to the ultimate benefit of its customers.
