ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 22, 2010, Charles Case (Respondent) filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (2) The parties participated in a prehearing conference on February 1, 2011, but did not resolve matters. Accordingly, in a February 16, 2011, entry, the attorney examiner scheduled a March 31, 2011, hearing.
- (3) On March 23, 2011, staff filed a motion for continuance of the March 31, 2011, hearing. Staff explained that additional time was needed to discuss resolution of the matter. The attorney examiner granted the continuance on March 23, 2011, to a date to be determined in a future entry.
- (4) Staff filed a motion to dismiss on March 25, 2011, stating that Respondent had paid the forfeiture in full, and adding that under Rule 4901:2-7-22, Ohio Administrative Code, full payment terminates all further proceedings in the matter.
- (5) Given the full payment of the forfeiture, staff's motion to dismiss shall be granted, and this case shall be closed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That staff's motion to dismiss be granted, and this case be closed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be sent to all parties of record.


