<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 5, 2010, Fetter & Son Farms LLC (Respondent) filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 490l:2-7-13, O.A.C
- (2) A prehearing conference was conducted on February 11, 2011, but the parties were unable to reach settlement. By entry issued on February 16, 2011, a hearing date of April 19, 2011, was scheduled.
- (3) On April 13, 2011, staff filed a motion for continuance of the hearing. The attorney examiner granted the motion in an April 19, 2011, entry.
- (4) On April 19, 2011, staff filed a motion to dismiss the case. Staff explained that Respondent had paid the forfeiture in full.
- (5) Rule 4901:2-7-22, Ohio Administrative Code, provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (6) In view of the payment of the forfeiture, staff's motion to dismiss shall be granted, and this case shall be closed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That staff's motion to dismiss be granted and the case be closed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
