# AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE OHIO BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY d/b/a AT&T OHIO AND TW TELECOM OF OHIO LLC ("TWTC")

This Amendment (the "Amendment") modifies the Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") by and between The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Ohio ("AT&T Ohio")<sup>1</sup> and Time Warner Telecom of Ohio, LLC n/k/a tw telecom of ohio IIc ("TWTC"). AT&T Ohio and TWTC are hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".

WHEREAS, AT&T Ohio and TWTC are Parties to an Interconnection Agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), effective April 17, 2002 and as subsequently amended;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") November 22, 2010 Finding and Order ("Order") in Case No. 08-1215-TP-CSS, the Parties are modifying the Transit Traffic rates in the Agreement;

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises and mutual agreements set forth herein, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. The Recitals herein are incorporated into this Amendment.
- 2. Pricing Schedules. The Parties agree that the Agreement will be amended by the revisions set forth in the revised Pricing Schedule attached hereto as Exhibit A. The rates in the Pricing Schedule to the Agreement are replaced with the applicable new rates as found in Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 Section 6.9.1.
- 3. This Amendment shall not modify or extend the Effective Date or Term of the underlying Agreement, but rather, shall be coterminous with the Agreement.
- 4. EXCEPT AS MODIFIED HEREIN, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE UNDERLYING AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
- 5. In entering into this Amendment, neither Party waives, and each Party expressly reserves, any rights, remedies or arguments it may have at law or under the intervening law or regulatory change provisions in the underlying Agreement (including intervening law rights asserted by either Party via written notice predating this Amendment) with respect to any orders, decisions, legislation or proceedings and any remands thereof, which the Parties have not yet fully incorporated into this Agreement or which may be the subject of further review.
- 6. This Amendment shall be filed with and is subject to approval by The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio and shall become effective upon filing with such Commission (the "Amendment Effective Date") and is deemed approved by operation of law on the 91<sup>st</sup> day after filing.
