The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The above-captioned applications were filed in accordance with Rule 4901:1-40-04(F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility as defined in Section 4928.01, Revised Code.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), O.A.C., each application is subject to a 60-day automatic approval process from the date of filing. The rule also provides that the Commission may suspend an application during the 60-day approval period.
- (3) With respect to each application, the Commission Staff has requested the application be suspended due to an issue with supporting documentation. Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process to further review these matters.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for each captioned application be suspended. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in each case.


