MOTION TO INTERVENE OF INDUSTRIAL ENERGY USERS-OHIO

Industrial Energy Users-Ohio ("IEU-Ohio") hereby respectfully moves the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission"), pursuant to Section 4903.221, Revised Code, and Rule 4901-1-11, Ohio Administrative Code, for leave to intervene in the above-captioned matter with the full powers and rights granted by the Commission, specifically by statute or by the provisions of the Ohio Administrative Code, to intervening parties.

In Columbus Southern Power Company's ("CSP") and Ohio Power Company's ("OPCo") (collectively "AEP" or "Companies") Electric Security Plans ("ESP") in Case Nos. 08-917-EL-SSO and 08-918-EL-SSO, the Commission by Order¹ issued March 18, 2009, as clarified by the Commission's Entry on Rehearing² issued July 23, 2009, approved fuel adjustment clauses ("FAC") for the Companies. In the Order modifying and approving the Companies' ESP, the Commission also approved an annual audit of

the accounting of the FAC costs in the ESP and authorized 2011 rate increases of six percent for CSP and eight percent for OPCo.

The interests of IEU-Ohio will not be adequately represented by other parties to the proceeding and, as such, IEU-Ohio is entitled to intervene with the full powers and rights granted by the Commission, specifically by statute and by the provisions of the Ohio Administrative Code, to intervening parties.
