ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 4, 2008, Frank Klanac (Mr. Klanac) filed a complaint against CenturyTel of Ohio, Inc. (CenturyTel), alleging that CenturyTel caused damage to his property by drilling through his drain tile to install an anchor for two guy wires.
- (2) On August 22, 2008, CenturyTel filed an answer denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) A hearing was held in this matter on August 19, 2009.
- (4) By entry dated December 20, 2010, Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison) was joined as a respondent in this case.
- (5) On January 21, 2011, Ohio Edison filed an answer denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (6) On May 27, 2011, Mr. Klanac, CenturyTel, and Ohio Edison filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, the parties stated that they have resolved all issues raised in this proceeding. The parties, therefore, requested that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (7) In view of the resolution of the complaint, the parties' request to dismiss this case, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


