The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On May 26, 2011, Norfolk Southern Railway Company (NS) filed a request that the Commission issue an order granting authority to remove a "No Turn" signal at the Seneca County Line Road grade crossing (472394U), located in Seneca County, Ohio. NS states that the "No Turn" signal is located on the west side of the crossing as was directed toward a driveway which formerly entered the roadway from a private property. The driveway has since been relocated, further west, thereby obviating the need for the "No Turn" signal. Therefore, NS requests authority to remove the "No Turn" signal.
- (2) On June 7, 2011, Staff filed a Staff Report recommending that NS's request be granted.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds it appropriate that the Green Creek Township Trustees and the Adams Township Trustees, as well as any other interested parties should have the opportunity to file comments on NS's request. Accordingly, any interested parties should file any comments on NS's request by July 15, 2011.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That any interested parties file any comments on NS's request by July 15, 2011. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on NS, Ohio Rail Development Commission, Seneca County engineer, Green Creek Township Trustees, Adams Township Trustees, and all other parties of record.
