I am writing you concerning the above-referenced case, at the request of my client; the Ohio Rail Development Commission ("ORDC"). The ORDC desires to express its support to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio for Cleveland Commercial Railroad's ("CCR") request to modify the due date for project 10-821-RR-FED.

The rationale for this request stems from the fact that the Ohio Department of Transportation and the Ohio Division of the Federal Highway Administration ("FHWA") are currently performing an extensive program review of all ORDC safety projects. As a result, a delay has occurred in the federal authorization of many ORDC safety projects. Therefore, ORDC concurs with the attached June 2 request of CCR that an extension of time to complete the project is necessary and reasonable and should be granted by the PUCO.

In the Matter of the Authorization of Cieveland Commercial Railroad to Begin a Consolidation Project in the City of Bedford, Cuyahoga County.

This letter is to request an extension of the project completion date from June 30, 2011, to an unspecified open date.

Cleveland Commercial Railroad's Contractors, Wintrow Construction Company (Wintrow) and Railroad Traffic Control (RTC), will not be able to complete this project by June 30, 2011, due to a delay in ORDC Project start authorization.
