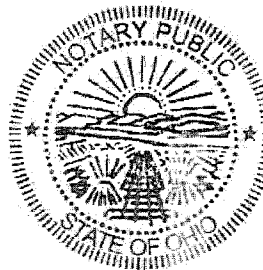

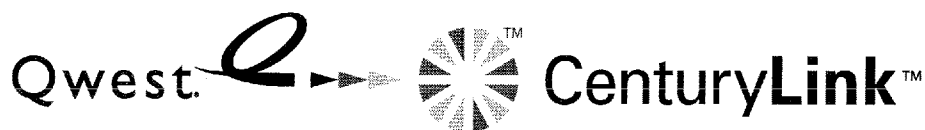
CenturyLink and Qwest are pleased to announce that our merger was completed on April 1, 2011.
