this Notice of Intervention, the Richland County Engineer states:

- 1. On March 10, 2011, Black Fork Wind Energy LLC ("Applicant") filed with the Ohio Power Siting Board an application for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need to site a wind-powered electric generation facility in Richland and Crawford counties pursuant to OAC Chapter 4906-17. The Board of County Commissioners of Richland County, Ohio was served with a copy of the application on or about June 20, 2011 pursuant to R.C. 4906.06(B).
- 2. The Richland County Engineer has the authority provided under Chapter 315, Ohio Revised Code. By the attached letter, the Richland County Engineer authorized the filing of this Notice of Intervention in this action. See Exhibit A attached.

These criteria include specifically the social and ecological criteria in OAC Rule 4906-17-08 as well as the specific economic, land use and community development criteria under OAC Rule
