<u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- On December 23, 2010, Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) filed an application to revise the section of its tariff relating to its Full Requirements Cooperative Transportation Service.
- (2) By entry issued May 31, 2011, the attorney examiner, *inter alia*, granted a motion to intervene filed by Knox Energy Cooperative Association (Knox) and scheduled this case for a conference to occur on July 11, 2011.
- (3) On July 8, 2011, Columbia filed a motion for a continuance of the July 11, 2011, conference. In support of its motion, Columbia explains that it has a scheduling conflict on July 11, 2011, with depositions being taken in another case pending before the Commission. Columbia also states that it has contacted Knox, who does not oppose the request for a continuance. Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds that Columbia's request for a continuance of the conference is reasonable and should be granted. The conference will be rescheduled by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Columbia's motion for a continuance be granted in accordance with finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
