Rule 4901:1-39-05(F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), permits a mercantile customer to file, either individually or jointly with an electric utility, an application to commit the customer's existing demand reduction, demand response, and energy efficiency programs for integration with the electric utility's programs. In each of the above captioned cases, the customer and Ohio Edison Company filed joint applications in accordance with the mercantile application pilot program found in Commission Order 10-834-EL-EEC.

On February 18, 2011, the automatic approval process was suspended for these cases, pursuant to Commission entry, to allow Staff time to obtain additional information and conduct further review of each filing.

Based on its further review, Staff recommends approval of the mercantile commitment applications and energy efficiency rebates as follows:
