JOINT APPLICATION TO TRANSFER A CERTIFICATE TO APPALACHIAN POWER COMPANY

Joint Applicants are AEP Generating Company ("AEGCo"), holder of a Certificate originally granted in this proceeding by the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") on February 12, 2001, and transferred to AEGCo by an Order of the Board dated August 20, 2007, and, Appalachian Power Company ("APCo"), the proposed transferee (together, "Joint Applicants")

In its Opinion, Order and Certificate, the Board approved Dresden's construction of a 580 megawatt electric combined-cycle, natural gas generating facility in Muskingum County, near Dresden, Ohio. The generating facility is now approximately 80% complete.

Joint Applicants intend to enter into an agreement whereby all the assets of this project, including the Certificate, permits and other authorizations pertaining to the Dresden generating facility, will be transferred from AEGCo to APCo. APCo plans to continue construction of the Dresden facility in accordance with the Certificate issued by the Board on February 12, 2001. It pledges to comply with the terms, conditions and modifications contained in the Certificate, as reflected in the attached letter.

Ohio Revised Code Section ("R.C.") 4906.04 applies to a change in ownership of the Certificate where a new third-party entity proposes to acquire the certificate and provides that the

Board determine whether a certificate should be transferred to the new third-party entity and, if so, to approve the transfer.

WHEREFORE, Joint Applicants respectfully request that pursuant to R.C. 4906.04, the Board find that it should approve the transfer of the Certificate to APCo.
