The Commission finds:


- (1) Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination (NPD) upon Steve Minor (Respondent) in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On June 3, 2011, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) By entry issued June 9, 2011, the attorney examiner scheduled a July 15, 2011, prehearing conference. The parties discussed the matter at the prehearing conference and continued discussions afterwards.
- (4) On June 30, 2011, staff filed a notice of dismissal in the case. Staff explains that upon further investigation, it has concluded that further prosecution of the matter is unwarranted, and indicates that it will withdraw the NPD sent to Mr. Minor. Further, states Staff, discussions with Mr. Minor led him to conclude that is no need to continue movement toward hearing. Therefore, states Staff, the parties request that the Commission dismiss the case and close it of record.
- (5) The Commission finds Staff's request to dismiss the matter is reasonable and should be granted.





ORDERED, That Staff's request to dismiss the matter be granted. It is, further,


