Dear Chairman Snitchler:

I recently wrote in support of AEP's Ohio Electric Security Plan Case Nos. 11-346-EL-SSO and 11-348-EL-SSO ("AEP's ESP"). I am now writing to clarify what the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank is in fact supporting. We are not supporting AEP's ESP. We have not reviewed the filing or evaluated its effects on the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank or the customers in which we serve. Our only goal is to fight hunger and feed Ohio's most vulnerable citizens.

We are supporting a single provision of AEP's ESP which provides for the continuation of the Partnership with Ohio Program which helps support our goal. Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank is appreciative of the support it receives from a number of companies, including AEP Ohio which helps support the distribution of millions of pounds of food every year.

We at the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank are not energy policy experts and we are unable to weigh the affects of other provisions within the plan. We believe the energy policy expertise and decision making authority has been entrusted to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. We trust that the PUCO will make the right decision that provides low cost electricity to the vulnerable customers in which we serve.
