AT&T'S REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF A
DECISION OF NEUSTAR - POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

SBC Internet Services, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Internet Services (SBCIS/ATTIS”) by its attorneys and pursuant to 47 CFR § 52.15(g)(3)(iv), respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (“Commission”) review and overturn the Pooling Administrator’s (“PA” or “NeuStar”) denial of SBCIS/ATTIS’ request for numbering resources, as more fully described herein. This request is based on the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) rules found at 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv) and pursuant to the Thousands-Block Number (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guidelines and the Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines published by the Industry Numbering Committee.¹

SBCIS/ATTIS is establishing a new switch (DYTNOH15EMD) for its Module 3 project for CVoIP/EVERSE which will roll out in November 2011. SBCIS/ATTIS needs to establish an LRN for the new switch and therefore is requesting one block: 937-460-9. Note that Block 7 was originally requested but it is already in use with Module 2. The Thousand Block Application Form was modified, accordingly, and attached. This block has been reserved via

PAS. Because the number pooling inventory is not showing any available block for assignment that could be used for an LRN, a new code will need to be opened and SBCIS/ATTIS will only keep Block 9; the rest of the blocks will be returned to the pool.

The FCC's rules identify a procedure whereby denial of a numbering resource request can be brought to the appropriate state commission for review. 47 CFR § 52.15(g)(3)(iv) provides as follows:

(iv) The NANPA shall withhold numbering resources from any U.S. carrier that fails to comply with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements established in this part. The NANPA shall not issue numbering resources to a carrier without an Operating Company Number (OCN). The NANPA must notify the carrier in writing of its decision to withhold numbering resources within ten (10) days of receiving a request for numbering resources. The carrier may challenge the NANPA's decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission. The state regulatory commission may affirm or overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination of compliance with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements herein.

In addition, the FCC's December 12, 2001 Order in its Number Resource Optimization Report and Order, CC Docket No. 99-200, FCC No. 01-362, paragraph 64 states that, "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e. vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers. SBCIS/ATTIS submits that its request constitutes special circumstances and demonstrates a clear requirement that warrants the Commission's review and reversal of NeuStar's decision.

Attached to this request are copies of SBCIS/ATTIS' Thousand Block Application Form, the Months-to-Exhaust Certification, a copy of NeuStar's denial, and a copy of SBCIS/ATTIS' request.

Although AT&T has an adequate supply of telephone numbers in this rate center to satisfy incremental requests without receiving additional numbers, AT&T's existing number resources cannot satisfy the needs for satisfying the needs for future IS customers. Nevertheless, SBCIS/ATTIS' request to obtain the required numbering resources from NeuStar will not be processed because SBCIS/ATTIS does not meet the two required FCC criteria to obtain numbering resources in the rate center. The FCC requires months-to-exhaust of six or fewer months. SBCI/ATTIS is at 3.481 MTE. In addition the FCC requires utilization of at least 75%. SBCIS/ATTIS is at 34.20%. The NPA 937 is due to exhaust in 4Q2015.

SBCIS/ATTIS respectfully requests that the Commission overturn the PA's decision and issue the state waiver required to allow SBCIS/ATTIS to obtain a code for NANPA and assign one block.

Part 1A

Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under “Block Applicant” the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator’s name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia™ Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI™ tandem of the facilities based provider^{ix}. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. They also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia™ Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI™ tandem of the facilities based provider^{xi}. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. They also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Initial requests are for first applications for thousands-blocks in a rate center, growth for additional thousands-blocks in a rate center in which the applicant already has numbering resources, and provide the required evidence as ordered by the FCC.

Section 1.6 Service Providers must indicate the updated/current information in regards to contaminated TNs on the block they are returning to the pool. Blocks with over 10% contamination (101 TNs or more) shall not be returned to the pool unless they meet criteria outlined in section 9.1.2 of these Guidelines. If the block being returned is over 10% contaminated the PA shall seek a new block holder. If question c and/or d have a response of No, the request for return shall be denied.
