ENTRY

The Commission finds:


- (1) On June 29, 2011, and July 21, 2011, the United Transportation Union and the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen filed complaints in the above-captioned cases. The complaints allege that Wheeling and Lake Erie Railway Co. and the Norfolk Southern Railway Company, created unsafe and hazardous conditions on their respective property that endanger railroad employees in the performance of their duties.
- (2) Staff has filed findings that the conditions giving rise to the complaints have been eliminated and requesting the cases be dismissed. Accordingly, these complaints should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the Commission dismisses the complaints filed in these cases.
It is, further,

ORDERED, That the Commission serve a copy of this entry upon all parties of record.


