# MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TESTIMONY AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED RULING BY THE DAYTON POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

The Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L"), pursuant to Rules 4901-1-12(C) and 4901-1-13(A) of the Ohio Administrative Code respectfully moves for a one week extension of time to file testimony in this proceeding from the currently scheduled date of October 4, 2011, to October 11, 2011, and further moves for expedited consideration. A prior extension was previously granted in an order issued September 26, 2011.

A draft stipulation with widespread support among the parties has been circulated to all the parties and is currently under review. The one week extension is requested to finalize and file the stipulation. Assuming that occurs, the scheduled hearing could be used to take oral testimony in support of the stipulation. If, for some reason, there is no stipulation agreed to among the parties, DP&L would intend to move for a postponement of the hearing data, which it would file sometime next week.

Users-Ohio, and FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. and can certify that no party objects to the issuance of a ruling without the opportunity to file a memoranda contra.

These Motions should be granted for good cause on an expedited basis, for the reasons more fully set forth in the accompanying memorandum in support.
