13	At this time we will take appearances.
14	First, on behalf of the company.
15	MR. PETRICOFF: Thank you, your Honor.
16	May it please the Power Siting Board, on behalf of
17	the applicant, Blackfork Wind Energy, I'd like to
18	enter the appearance of Howard Petricoff and Mike
19	Settineri of the law firm of Vorys, Sater, Seymour
20	and Pease, 52 East Gay Street, Columbus, Ohio.
21	EXAMINER FARKAS: On behalf of the staff.
22	MR. JONES: Good morning. On behalf of
23	the staff of the Ohio Power Siting Board, Ohio
24	Attorney General Mike Dewine, assistant attorneys
25	general Steve Reilly, Devin Parram, and John Jones,

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180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio. 1 EXAMINER FARKAS: On behalf of the Farm 2 3 Bureau. 4 MR. ENDSLEY: Good morning, Your Honor. 5 On behalf of the Southeastern Farm Bureau Federation, 6 Chad Endsley. 7 EXAMINER FARKAS: On behalf of the Board 8 of Crawford County and Richland County. 9 MR. COLLIER: On behalf of the Richland 10 and Crawford County Commissioners, the Richland 11 County Engineer, I'd like to enter an appearance for 12 intervention of the law firm of Benesch, Friedlander, Coplan & Aronoff, Orla Collier, 41 South High Street, 13 Columbus, Ohio. 14 15 EXAMINER FARKAS: And just for the 16 record, that would include the Board of Crawford 17 County Commissioners, the Board of Richland County Commissioners, the Richland County Engineer, 18 19 Plymouth, Sharon, and Sandusky Townships? 20 MR. COLLIER: That's correct. 21 EXAMINER FULLIN: I was thinking to the 22 extent we need to identify you separate from the 23 other intervenors, I might refer to you as the 24 statutory intervenors because you entered the case 25 through a different statutory process than the other

intervenors. That may be something that I refer to 1 2 as the hearing goes on. 3 MR. COLLIER: Thank you. EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. John Warrington, 4 5 is he present? 6 MR. WARRINGTON: John Warrington. 7 EXAMINER FARKAS: State your address for 8 the record. 9 MR. WARRINGTON: 7040 State Route 96, Tiro, Ohio, 44887. 10 11 EXAMINER FARKAS: Thank you. 12 Loren Gledhill. 13 Carol Gledhill. 14 Neither of them are present. 15 Mary Studer. 16 Mary Studer is not present. 17 Alan or Catherine Price. MS. PRICE: I am Catherine Price. This 18 19 is my husband, Alan Price, 7956 Remlinger Road, 20 Crestline, Ohio, 44827. 21 EXAMINER FARKAS: Thank you. 2.2 Thomas Karbula. MR. KARBULA: Thomas Karbula, 3026 23 24 Solinger Road, Crestline, Ohio 44827. 25 EXAMINER FARKAS: Nick or Margaret

Rietschlin. 1 2 MS. RIETSCHLIN: Margaret Rietschlin, 3 R-I-E-T-S-C-H-L-I-N, 4240 Baker Road, Crestline, 4 Ohio, 44827. 5 EXAMINER FARKAS: Thank you. 6 Bradley and Debra Bauer. They are not present in the hearing room. 7 8 Grover Reynolds. 9 Mr. Reynolds is not present. 10 Brett Heffner. 11 MR. HEFFNER: Brett A. Heffner, 3429 12 Stein Road, Shelby, Ohio, 44875. 13 EXAMINER FARKAS: Gary Biglin. MR. BIGLIN: Gary J. Biglin, B-I-G-L-I-N, 14 15 5531 State Route 61 South, Shelby, Ohio, 44875. 16 EXAMINER FARKAS: And Karel Davis. 17 MS. DAVIS: Karel, K-A-R-E-L, Davis, 6675 18 Champion Road, Shelby, Ohio, 44875. 19 EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. That is the list 20 of intervenors of record. Are there other -- well, 21 that's it. 2.2 Just for the record, the testimony that 23 we have filed in the case to date is from the 24 company, Courtney Dohoney, Jay Haley, Scott Hawken Kenneth Kaliski, Todd Mattson, James Mawhorr, Diane 25

1 Mundt, David Stoner, Dale Arnold. 2 Upon behalf of the Ohio Farm Bureau 3 Federation, William Schroeder, a private citizen, 4 prefiled by the company. 5 For Crawford County you have Doug 6 Weisenauer, Crawford County Engineer, Cecil Newcome. 7 Richland County, Edward Olson and Tim 8 Wert, Richland County Engineer, Thomas Beck. 9 From the staff we have Timothy Burgener, Andrew Conway, Christopher Cunningham, Nicholas Doss, 10 Paul Laurent, Jon Pawley, Donald Rostofer, John 11 12 Whitis. 13 And the individuals who prefiled 14 testimony and were granted intervention Karel Davis, 15 Margaret Rietschlin, Nick Rietschlin, John 16 Warrington. That is all the individuals that 17 prefiled testimony. 18 Yes, sir. 19 MR. HEFFNER: I filed mine within the 20 deadline. It has not been posted. Was there some 21 mishap? I sent it to all parties. EXAMINER FARKAS: There's nothing 2.2 23 docketed from Mr. Heffner. Was something sent? 24 MR. SETTINERI: We are not aware of 25 receiving anything.

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EXAMINER FARKAS: Is staff aware of 1 2 receiving anything? 3 MR. JONES: No, your Honor. 4 EXAMINER FARKAS: Nothing has been 5 docketed. The Direct Testimony of 6 MR. HEFFNER: Brett A. Heffner, I have a proof of service fax. 7 Ιt 8 was sent to the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation. It was sent to the 21 people listed on here, September 15, 9 2011. 10 11 EXAMINER FARKAS: You sent it by regular 12 mail or e-mail? 13 MR. HEFFNER: There was a fax to the fax number of the Ohio Power Siting Board. It was sent 14 15 by regular mail to everybody on that list. 16 EXAMINER FARKAS: Did any of the parties 17 receive the testimony of Mr. Heffner? The individuals are indicating they have 18 but none of the other parties have. 19 20 EXAMINER FULLIN: The docket did not 21 receive it. 2.2 MR. HEFFNER: Docketing division, it was both faxed and mailed. 23 24 EXAMINER FARKAS: When did you mail it? 25 MR. HEFFNER: September 15.

1 EXAMINER FARKAS: You mailed it on the 2 15th? 3 MR. HEFFNER: That's right. 4 EXAMINER FARKAS: It probably wouldn't 5 have been docketed on the 15th since it was mailed on 6 the 15th. 7 Yes, sir, identify yourself. 8 MR. BIGLIN: Gary Biglin. Likewise, I 9 haven't seen my testimony posted. I mailed it out 10 regular mail on the 14th of September, and as far as 11 down here at this office, Timothy Burgener -- is that 12 how you say it? I sent it to this address to him in 13 care of the docketing division, and also -- is it Donnelly Hunter? 14 15 EXAMINER FULLIN: Donnell Hunter. 16 MR. BIGLIN: Also to that individual at this address. I sent it in care of the docketing 17 division on September 14, but I have not seen 18 19 anything on line recognizing that. 20 Thank you. 21 EXAMINER FARKAS: Thank you. 2.2 MR. ENDSLEY: Your Honor, if we may be 23 heard, we received a copy of Mr. Biglin's testimony. 24 EXAMINER FARKAS: You did receive that? 25 MR. BIGLIN: I sent it to all parties,

1 Your Honor. As far as in the building, those are the 2 two I sent it to. Thank you. 3 EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. Thank you. 4 It's possible that something may have been posted as of the 16th. Do you have copies of 5 6 your testimony? 7 MR. HEFFNER: I have a copy, and I can 8 get copies today. Is the testimony going to be 9 needed before Wednesday? 10 EXAMINER FARKAS: No. 11 MR. HEFFNER: I will be happy to get 12 copies if that would be suitable. 13 MR. BIGLIN: I have copies, your Honor. 14 I sent them out, but I have copies here, too. 15 EXAMINER FARKAS: On an initial basis is 16 there any objection to Mr. Heffner's or Mr. Biglin's 17 testimony being accepted as being late filed? MR. PETRICOFF: No, your Honor. Assuming 18 if there is a problem, I don't anticipate one, if we 19 20 could have an extra day or two since we didn't get 21 it, that would be fine. We will probably be able to 2.2 do this on time. 23 EXAMINER FARKAS: How many pages is your 24 testimony, Mr. Heffner, just for the record? 25 MR. HEFFNER: Without the proof of

1 service, nine pages. EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. Is it typed? 2 3 MR. HEFFNER: It's handwritten. 4 EXAMINER FARKAS: Mr. Biglin. 5 MR. BIGLIN: I'd like to clarify. As 6 well as sending it out ahead of time to all the parties, I wasn't sure I would have to have another 7 8 copy here today or Wednesday, so I do have them. 9 They were sent out on the 14th. 10 EXAMINER FARKAS: I would say if you have 11 yours available right now, you can distribute them 12 when we conclude so we will all have them. 13 MR. BIGLIN: As long as that covers it 14 for Wednesday. 15 EXAMINER FARKAS: No party has an 16 objection to the filing of your testimony. 17 MR. BIGLIN: Your Honor, I am not clear on the code. We sent it via the mail, but as far as 18 19 giving people copies at the hearing, is this the 20 hearing, or is Wednesday the hearing we need to do 21 that? 2.2 EXAMINER FARKAS: What we are going to do 23 is today -- you can have a seat. Today what we will 24 do, the purpose of the proceeding today was to 25 initially take appearances, discuss any procedural

1	matters that the parties had, and then to adjourn the
2	hearing itself but reconvene on Wednesday, start the
3	hearing at 1:00 o'clock, but allow the parties the
4	time to conduct settlement negotiations today and
5	tomorrow, if they so choose, and, you know, if they
6	are fruitful, whatever, we will deal with that as it
7	comes about.
8	But the testimony was due on the 15th,
9	and based on your representation and Mr. Heffner's
10	representation, and the parties don't seem to object
11	to having the testimony presented by you on
12	Wednesday, if that's when it is. It may not be
13	Wednesday. It may be the day after Wednesday, but we
14	will start on Wednesday. Your testimony will be
15	accepted as if it was filed timely.
16	MR. BIGLIN: Thank you.
17	EXAMINER FARKAS: That would be the same
18	for you, Mr. Heffner.
19	Now, you had a question?
20	MS. PRICE. My name is Catherine Price,
21	and my testimony and my husband's, Alan Price's
22	testimony, both were sent out on the 14th by
23	overnight mail and to be signed for by all parties
24	involved.
25	EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay.

1 Does any party have an objection to their 2 testimony being considered timely filed if you don't It doesn't show on the docketing card. 3 have it? 4 Do you have copies available as to your 5 testimony? 6 MS. PRICE: Yes. 7 MR. PETRICOFF: We have not received it, 8 but as long as we get a copy, we will not object to 9 it. EXAMINER FARKAS: Staff or for the Farm 10 11 Bureau? 12 MR. JONES: No objection, your Honor. 13 MR. ENDSLEY: No objection from the Farm 14 Bureau. 15 EXAMINER FARKAS: And the counties? 16 MR. COLLIER: No objection. 17 EXAMINER FARKAS: Hearing none, the Prices' testimony will be considered as timely filed. 18 19 And I would ask that you provide copies 20 today to all the parties, so at a break, there's 21 copying at docketing so you can get copies made. 2.2 That's on this floor. 23 Yes, sir. 24 MR. BIGLIN: So that would be for us 25 also, whoever wants them today?

1 EXAMINER FARKAS: Yes. 2 EXAMINER FULLIN: Since most people are 3 here today, you should distribute them. 4 MR. BIGLIN: I'm trying to get it clear. 5 EXAMINER FARKAS: Right. EXAMINER FULLIN: You could distribute it 6 7 to all the parties here today if you have enough 8 copies. The parties that didn't make an appearance, 9 I would say that it would be acceptable just to leave one copy in docketing and they could download it to 10 11 the docketing card. 12 EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. 13 MR. KARBULA: I want to have it known I 14 did send copies on the 15th, and I do have copies. 15 EXAMINER FULLIN: Without objection, I 16 will make the same ruling with respect to 17 Mr. Karbula's testimony. It is considered timely filed and can be distributed to parties here today. 18 19 And I guess for each of those parties in 20 that category, if you also leave one copy while 21 you're here today at docketing so it will get 22 docketed today no matter what happened to the one in 23 the mail. That way it will be docketed and people 24 could find it in the docketing system after today. 25 EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay. All right.

1	EXAMINER FULLIN: I think that was the
2	main thing we wanted to clarify. Is there any other
3	party out there that made an attempt to prefile
4	testimony and it is not clear whether it is in the
5	record yet or not?
6	EXAMINER FARKAS: Okay.
7	EXAMINER FULLIN: I think that was the
8	main thing we were trying to accomplish before we
9	adjourn.
10	We might also want to have a discussion
11	about I think we scheduled this as a settlement
12	conference and said we would call and continue it.
13	We would ask that the parties would bring a list of
14	the witnesses. Maybe we can spend some time on the
15	record discussing the order of witnesses that might
16	be scheduled on the record.
17	We can have an off-the-record discussion
18	about that and go on the record to describe what we
19	discussed, if that would be more productive.
20	MR. PETRICOFF: That would be fine. We
21	are willing to go off the record. We have made a
22	list of witnesses from the company and have put in
23	our dates, assuming that the company will go first,
24	as we're the applicant.
25	EXAMINER FARKAS: Yes.

1 MR. PETRICOFF: We can pass that out now. 2 We can go around and talk with the others off the 3 record in terms of presentation. EXAMINER FARKAS: Off the record. 4 5 (Discussion off the record.) EXAMINER FARKAS: Off the record there 6 7 was discussion among the parties as to the order of 8 witnesses that will testify in the hearing, and the 9 witnesses will go in this order: 10 On September 21, we will have for the 11 company Ms. Mundt, Mr. Stoner and Hawken. On the 22nd we will have Kaliski, Haley, Dohoney, Mattson, 12 13 Mawhorr and possibly Mr. Arnold and Schroeder, if time is available; otherwise, Mr. Arnold and 14 15 Schroeder will go on the 23rd in the morning. 16 Then on the afternoon of the 23rd of 17 September starting at 1:00 o'clock, the witnesses for Crawford and Richland Counties and any of the 18 19 townships will testify. 20 Then on the 26th of September, staff 21 witnesses will testify on the 26th and the 27th. 2.2 Beginning on the 28th we will start with 23 Mr. Heffner and then any of the other intervenor 24 parties will testify, and then if need be, we will 25 have the 30th for the last day of intervenor

1 testimony.

2 EXAMINER FULLIN: There will be no 3 hearing on the 29th.

EXAMINER FARKAS: No hearing on the 29th. The days will begin -- the 21st we will start at 1:00 o'clock, and then each of the other days we will start at 9:00 o'clock.

8 And then, for the record, we had a 9 discussion as to confidential documents and 10 settlement discussions for the record, we discussed 11 that confidential documents, and in order for the 12 parties to view confidential documents, they have to 13 agree to a confidentiality agreement, which would 14 preclude them from divulging or telling anyone else about that information and the discussions of 15 16 settlement that would take place at any time here 17 today or at any other time with respect to this case, with respect to any parties. They are considered 18 19 confidential between those parties and discussions of 20 settlement are not admissible in the hearing.

I believe that was it. So to the extent is there any other business that the parties have at this time?
