extension of time to complete a grade crossing project in Licking County

October 20, 2011

By its Entry date December 8, 2010, the Commission ordered that the Columbus & Ohio River Railroad (CUOH) replace the existing mast mounted flashing lights and roadway gates with new assemblies at Cedar St/SR 79, City of Newark, Licking County, DOT# 517478U on or before September 8, 2011 (the Ohio Rail Development Commission requested a nine month order for this project).

On September 7, 2011 the Commission granted a 30 day extension of the deadline, until October 10, 2011. CUOH requested the extension as a result of ODOT not having completed the roadway portion of the project.

On October 20, 2011, CUOH filed a further request for a nine month extension of time, due to ODOT's estimation that the roadway work will not be completed until the Spring of 2012. CUOH notes that all work that can be completed on its part has been done.

Staff requests that the Attorney Examiner issue a 30 day extension of time for this project in order to allow the Commission time to further consider the railroad's request.
