Movants also request that the Commission grant movants' motion on an expedited basis pursuant to O.A.C. 4901-1-12(C). The reasons for this motion are set forth more fully in the attached memorandum.¹

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

On September 1, 2011, Duke submitted an application for approval to adjust and set the Annually Adjusted Component Rider of its Standard Service Offer., in the above-captioned proceeding. By entry dated September 5, 2011, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule setting a date for the filing of comments and an evidentiary hearing as follows:

- (1) November 7, 2011 Deadline for the filing of motions to intervene.
- (2) November 7, 2011 Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by Staff and intervenors.
- (3) November 14, 2011 Deadline for all parties to file reply comments.
- (4) November 21, 2011 In the event all of the issues raised in the comments are not resolved, or if the Commission deems the application may be unjust or unreasonable, a hearing will be held, and Staff and intervenor testimony will be due on this date.
- (5) November 28, 2011 In the event a hearing is deemed necessary. Duke's supplemental testimony will be due on this day.
- (6) December 5, 2011 In the event a hearing is deemed necessary, the hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, 11-C Columbus, Ohio 43215.

For the reasons set forth below, movants request a 60-day extension which would amend the procedural schedule as follows:

(1) January 6, 2012 - Deadline for the filing of motions to intervene.

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- (2) January 6, 2012 Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by Staff and intervenors.
- (3) January 13, 2012 Deadline for all parties to file reply comments.
- (4) January 20, 201112 In the event all of the issues raised in the comments are not resolved, or if the Commission deems the application may be unjust or unreasonable, a hearing will be held, and Staff and intervenor testimony will be due on this date.
- (5) January 27, 2011 In the event a hearing is deemed necessary. Duke's supplemental testimony will be due on this day.
- (6) February 3, 2011 In the event a hearing is deemed necessary, the hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, 11-C Columbus, Ohio 43215.

Duke entered into a Stipulation and Recommendation with numerous parties in its Standard

Service Offer Case (Case Nos. 11-3549-EL-SSO, *et. al.*). If the Standard Service Offer Stipulation and Recommendation is approved by the Commission, this proceeding may not be necessary. Staff's audits are currently scheduled for this week in preparation for the November 7th comment deadline. To avoid unnecessary work performing an audit that may not be necessary in the event a Stipulation is approved, movants respectfully request an extension as described above. If for some reason the Stipulation and Recommendation is not approved, the procedural schedule should commence as proposed above.

O.A.C. 4901-1-12(C) allows a party to request that the Commission consider a motion on an expedited basis. Accordingly, Staff and Duke respectfully request an expedited ruling that the procedural schedule be postponed by 60 days. The undersigned counsel for Staff has been given the authority to make and sign this motion on behalf of all the other parties to this proceeding.
