Public Utilities Commission of Ohio
Local Public Hearing, in the Matter of the
Application of Columbus Southern Power and Ohio
Power Company, individually, and collectively as
AEP, for authority for an increase in electric
distribution rates, tariff approval and approval
to change accounting methods.

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1 MS. WILLEY: The Public Utilities
2 Commission of Ohio has called, for
3 public hearing at this time and place,
4 Case Numbers 11-351-EL-AIR and
5 11-352-EL-AIR, captioned: In the Matter
6 of the Application of Columbus Southern
7 Power Company and Ohio Power Company,
8 individually, and if their proposed
9 merger is approved, as a merged company,
10 collectively AEP Ohio, for an increase
11 in electric distribution rates.

12 Also Case Numbers 11-353-EL-ATA and
13 11-354-EL-ATA captioned: In the Matter
14 of the Application of Columbus Southern
15 Power Company, and Ohio Power, Company
16 individually, and if their proposed
17 merger is approved, as a merged company
18 for tariff approval, and Case Numbers
19 11-356-EL-AAM and 11-358-EL-AAM
20 captioned: In the Matter of the
21 Application of Columbus Southern Power
22 Company and Ohio Power Company,
23 individually, and if their proposed
24 merger is approved, as a merged company
25 for approval to change accounting

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1 methods.

2 My name is Mandy Willey and I'm an
3 attorney examiner assigned by the
4 Commission to conduct this public
5 hearing this evening. Along with me is
6 Sara Ziegler who you just heard speak
7 from the Commission's office of public
8 affairs. And as you came in, Pam
9 Siripavaket of the Commission staff who
10 represents the Service Monitoring
11 Enforcement Department of the
12 Commission.

13 At this time, I would like to take
14 appearances of the parties. That would
15 include the company, as well as any
16 interveners who are present. Let's
17 begin with the company.

18 MS. VOGAL: My name is Ann Vogal.
19 I'm an attorney Ohio Power Company and
20 Columbus Southern Power Company. And
21 with me here today is Selwyn Dias, vice
22 president of the companies. And there
23 are other representatives of the
24 companies here to answer any questions.

25 MS. WILLEY: Thank you.

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1 Are there any interveners present
2 this evening that would like to enter an
3 appearance?

4 It appears there are no interveners
5 present this evening.

6 On February 28th, 2011 Columbus
7 Southern Power Company and Ohio Power
8 Company, which are operating companies
9 of American Electric Power Ohio, filed
10 an application with the Commission for
11 an increase in electric distribution
12 rates, for tariff approval, and for
13 approval to change of accounting
14 methods. This local public hearing is
15 only one aspect of the case process.
16 Public hearings are also scheduled to
17 occur in Canton, Lima, and Columbus. An
18 evidentiary hearing is also currently
19 schedule to begin on November 14th, 2011
20 at 10:00 at the PUCO offices in
21 Columbus.

22 The purpose of the evidentiary
23 hearing is for the companies and the
24 Commission staff to present their expert
25 witness testimony and provide evidence

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1 in support of their position. The
2 purpose of tonight's hearing, however,
3 is to receive comments from the public.
4 We will not be hearing from the
5 companies tonight, as we already have
6 their proposal. But tonight is about
7 hearing from the public and to get your
8 feedback on what you think about the
9 company's application.

10 When you arrived, you were offered
11 the opportunity to sign up to testify.
12 So I will call your name in a few
13 minutes here. I will ask you to give
14 your name and address. And then you can
15 come up here to the podium and testify.
16 I will ask you to take an oath that what
17 you're about to say is the truth before
18 you give your testimony.

19 Your testimony this evening will be
20 considered part of the official record
21 in this case and will be reviewed by the
22 commissioners before they make their
23 final decision in this case. Attorney's
24 for the company and other interveners,
25 they may ask questions about your

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1 testimony if they wish to. And if you decide
2 that you don't want to testify when I call your
3 name, you can just indicate that you want to
4 pass. And you may also leave at any time that
5 you wish.

6 As you can see, there is a court reporter
7 present and this entire hearing is being
8 transcribed by a court reporter, so she is
9 writing everything down in a type-written
10 fashion. If you do plan to testify, please speak
11 plainly and clearly so she can accurately reflect
12 your comments. And the Commission sincerely
13 appreciates your participation in the hearing
14 tonight.

15 Does anyone have questions before we begin
16 taking testimony?

17 Yes.

18 MALE AUDIENCE MEMBER: I just wanted to ask a
19 question. I'm a State Representative. You had a
20 more modest recommendation for the price
21 increase. I don't know whether -- are you
22 prepared to answer questions regarding that?

23 MS. WILLEY: The questions I'm taking at this
24 point would just be about the process that we're
25 following this evening. But you can feel free to

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1 put any questions in the form of
2 comments on the record, or you can ask
3 us any questions after we're done taking
4 testimony, if you wish to do that.
5 Thank you very much.

6 All right. I would like to call
7 the sole witness on the sign-in sheet.
8 That's Robin Bozian. You can come up
9 here to the podium.

10 And Ms. Bozain, I apologize if I
11 mispronounced your name. Could you state
12 and spell your name and also give your
13 address?

14 MS. BOZIAN: Sure. My name is
15 Robin Bozian, spelled B-O-Z-I-A-N, the
16 last name. My address is 749 Ellis Run
17 Road, Cutler, Ohio, 45724.

18 MS. WILLEY: Thank you.

20 ROBIN BOZIAN

21 After having been first duly sworn, as
22 hereinafter certified, was examined and testified
23 as follows:

24 MS. WILLEY: Thank you.

25 MS. BOZIAN: Thank you. My name is

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1 Robin Bozian, as I said. I'm a resident
2 here in Washington County and I'm also a
3 current AEP Customer. In addition to
4 that, I work in an agency that works
5 with low-income individuals on a daily
6 basis, and I'm a member of a number of
7 boards and community organizations that
8 work with low-income individuals.

9 This increase comes at a
10 particularly bad time for many of my
11 friends and neighbors and folks that I
12 work with. The economic downturn has
13 hit southeast Ohio particularly hard and
14 perhaps the worst section of the state.
15 If you look at the recent poverty map,
16 you'll see that southeastern Ohio is
17 particularly hit hard in that arena.

18 Not only that, from past
19 experience, the prosperity and the
20 growth, as it typically happens within
21 the state, southeastern Ohio typically
22 lags farther behind. In other words,
23 when it starts to grow better in other
24 areas of the state, southeastern Ohio
25 eventually will, but it will come at a

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1 later time. So this kind of increase is
2 particularly hard hit.

3 Not only is this a bad time because
4 of the current economic climate. Even
5 though we're not talking about the
6 generation rates, I think it's important
7 to acknowledge that that rate increase
8 is being requested. Because if
9 approved, this increase plus that
10 increase, if approved, will create an
11 incredible burden on some of the most
12 vulnerable of our folks.

13 In our area, particularly in a
14 rural ares, if you don't have electric,
15 it's not like you just don't have
16 lights. It often means that you don't
17 have water because your electric is the
18 way you get water from your water well.
19 So it hits -- it hits a lot of our rural
20 areas even harder than one can imagine.
21 And even if you have wood, the electric
22 might -- often runs the blower and the
23 other heat-generated things. In
24 addition to the fact that you can't
25 ignore this other increase that's coming

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1 down and being requested, and as I
2 understand it, there is some settlement
3 negotiations that appear to suggest that
4 there will be an increase; on top of
5 that increase, it is my understanding
6 that AEP has also requested to
7 simultaneously reduce the amount of
8 low-income assistance available. And
9 that, coupled with these increases,
10 makes it doubly difficult to imagine how
11 folks are going to make it through.
12 It's not a good time for southeastern
13 Ohio. It's certainly not a good time
14 for the most vulnerable in our
15 community. And this is not a time to be
16 proposing these kinds of increases.
17 Thank you.

18 MS. WILLEY: Thank you very much.

19 That concludes the witnesses who
20 signed up to testify. Is there anyone
21 in the audience now who would like to
22 testify?

23 Okay. Seeing no one, I would like
24 to thank everyone for coming here this
25 everything. This will conclude this

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evening's public hearing, and this will
be submitted on the record for the
Commission's consideration in this case.
I would encourage the company
representatives to stick around for a
few minutes, and Ms. Ziegler and I will
stick around for a few minutes if you
have any questions of us.

Thank you, and have a nice evening.

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
