SECTION 24 EXCHANGE SERVICES

A. GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 1. The schedules of basic monthly exchange rates and charges applicable within the base and locality rate areas in the various exchange areas for the services offered therein are shown in Section 29 of this tariff. C. REMOTE CALL FORWARDING

1. General

Remote call forwarding (RCF) is a service which allows a call placed from a station to a customer's telephone number (the call forwarding location) to be automatically forwarded by Telephone Company central office equipment to another station designated by the RCF customer (the terminating station) which is (1) interexchange, (2) local exchange service, (3) 800 service (Inward Wide Area Telecommunications Service), or (4) foreign exchange service (FX). Additionally, RCF may also be used with foreign exchange service to forward calls via network facilities when the foreign exchange line is busy. This service is available only where the terminating station has incoming-call dial capability.

- 2. Limitations of the Service
- a) RCF service is offered subject to the availability of suitable facilities.
- b) RCF service is not offered where the terminating station is a coin telephone.
- c) The Telephone Company will not provide identification of the originating telephone number to the RCF customer.
- d) Transmission characteristics may vary depending on the distance and routing necessary to complete the remotely forwarded call.
- e) RCF is not represented as being suitable for satisfactory transmission of data.
- f) Regular call forwarding should not be offered as a feature at the RCF terminating station.
- Remote call forwarding is provided on the condition that the customer subscribes to sufficient RCF features and facilities to adequately handle calls to the terminating station(s) without interfering with or impairing any services offered by the Telephone Company. If in the opinion of the Telephone Company, additional RCF features at the call forwarding RCF features and facilities. In the event the customer refuses to subscribe for these additional RCF features and facilities, the customer's RCF service will be subject to termination.
- 3. Rates
- a) The rates and charges shown below are for the remote call forwarding feature only and are in addition to applicable rates and charges for service and equipment with which it is used.
- b) Remote call forwarding per feature arranged. See Section 29
- c) Message Charges See Section 29
- (1) The message charges applicable to remotely forwarded calls are comprised of two separate charges: (I) a charge for the portion of the call from the originating station to the call forwarding location, and (ii) a charge for the portion of the call from the call forwarding location to the terminating station. The respective charge for each such portion is to be as follows:
- (a) Between the originating station and call forwarding location: The charge for this portion of a remotely forwarded call will be the charge applicable for the type of call involved.

C. REMOTE CALL FORWARDING

- 3.c) Message Charges (Cont'd.)
- (b) Between the call forwarding location and the terminating station

The remote call forwarding customer is responsible for the applicable customer-dialed station-to-station toll charge. On local calls, the customer is responsible for the payment of a charge equivalent to the usage rates for originated customer dialed optional measured service calls. Usage allowances are not applicable to RCF. The preceding charges apply to all calls answered at the terminating station, including person-to-person and collect calls, even though such calls might not be accepted at the answering location.

d) Number Changes See Section 29

The initial charge applies each time:

- 1) The number is changed at the call forwarding location.
- 2) The number to which calls are forwarded is changed at the request of the customer.
- e) Directory Listings See Section 29

One listing is provided without additional charge in the directory covering the exchange in which the call forwarding central office is located.

f) Minimum Service Period

The minimum service period for this service is two months.

D. SELECTIVE CLASS OF CALL SCREENING SERVICE

- General
- a) Selective class of call screening service enables a customer, through Telephone Company operator identification, to restrict outgoing toll calls from the customer's station users. Only toll calls which are charged to the called telephone number, a third number, or a Telephone Company calling card account are permitted.
- b) All local calls and calls to Telephone Company numbers such as repair service, directory assistance, and Public emergency service numbers such as 911 will be permitted from the establishment.
- c) This service is available only where facilities permit, to colleges or universities, hospitals, hotels, motels, and other such institutions.
- 2. Rates and Charges See Section 29
- a) Per establishment
- b) Per trunk (toll access) line or special recording trunk equipped

E. SPECIAL REVERSED CHARGE TOLL SERVICE

- 1. General
- a) Special Reversed Charge Toll Service allows a customer in one exchange to arrange for patrons in one or more other exchanges to be able to call him without paying a toll charge and without requesting reversal of the charge.
- b) This service is available only to customers PBX service, or individual line service except semi-public service.
- c) The Telephone Company assigns a special call number designation for the use of patrons in each exchange in which the transfer service is to be furnished.
- d) Calls for the special number designation are accepted only when originated at station sets located in the exchange to which the special number had been assigned and only calls placed by calling the special number are considered as coming within the scope of the service.
- e) Customers contracting for Special Reversed Charge Toll Service assume all charges for completed calls to their special numbers.
- 2. Rates and Charges See Section 29
- a) Special Reversed Charge Toll Service, including one directory listing, if desired, per each exchange for which the service is furnished.
- b) Each completed call made in connection with Special Reversed Charge Toli Service is charged for at the established rate for a completed sent paid station-to-station operator-handled toll call.
- 3. Additional directory listings may be provided at charges shown in Sections 4 and 29 of this tariff.

F. TOUCH-TONE CALLING SERVICE

General

Touch-Tone calling service is an adjunct to exchange service and provides for the origination of calls using instruments equipped for tone-type address signaling and special central office facilities. Where the customer has the capability to originate exchange type calls using any type of instrument equipped for tone-type address signaling the rate and charges shown in this section apply.

- 2. Rates and Charges Section 29
- a) The rates and charges shown below apply in addition to all rates and charges applicable to the equipment, service and facilities furnished in connection with Touch-Tone calling service.
- (1) Individual, Non-Residence lines, per line equipped:
- (2) Wide Area Telecommunications Service (WATS) access line
- (3) Semi-Public service
- (4) Trunk line, hospital trunk line or hotel trunk line, per line equipped

F. TOUCH-TONE CALL SERVICE

- 2.A) Rates and Charges (contd.)
- (5) The initial, non-recurring, charge for establishing Touch-Tone calling service for individual line non-residence service, does not apply during selected times of special promotions of this service. This provision is applicable only when customers establish new or additional Touch-Tone calling service during the promotional period.
- (6) All orders for Touch-Tone calling service which are placed during special promotional periods will be honored under the terms of this provision if the service is installed during the promotional period or within a normal installation interval thereafter, or for any period during which the installation interval must be extended for reasons beyond the control of the customer.

- d) The customer has exclusive responsibility and control over the content, quality and characteristics of speech used in the recording. PTS and the Telephone Company assume no liability for the quality of, defects in, or contents of the recording. The customer must exclude from the message or announcement any matter whose dissemination is prohibited by law. In the event that the contents of the customer's message or announcement are found to be unlawful by any appropriate law enforcement or regulatory agency, PTS and or the Telephone Company reserves the right to refuse service or to terminate service upon receipt of an order from that agency so directing.
- 4. Rates
- a) When customer-provided terminal equipment employed for public announcement service is connected to facilities of the Telephone Company the following rates apply:
