The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Lyden Oil Company (Lyden), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code, alleging that Lyden was in violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) By entry of September 23, 2011, a hearing was scheduled for November 17, 2011.
- (3) On November 2, 2011, the staff filed a motion to continue the hearing to December 15, 2011. In the motion, staff indicated that the witness for the inspection report has a scheduling conflict on November 17, 2011. Staff also notes that it has discussed the motion with Lyden and it does not object to a continuance of the hearing.
- (4) Accordingly, staff's motion should be granted and the hearing should be continued from November 17, 2011, to December 15, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-D, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


