



1 am writing to request commission approval of the Electric Security Plan stipulation, as filed by AEP Ohio, in dockets 11-346-EL-SSO and 11-348-EL-SSO.

Spectra Energy Corp, a FORTUNE 500 company, is one of North America's premier natural gas infrastructure companies serving three key links in the natural gas value chain: gathering and processing, transmission and storage, and distribution. For nearly a century, Spectra Energy and its predecessor companies have developed critically important pipelines and related infrastructure connecting natural gas supply sources to premium markets. We have operated interstate natural gas pipeline facilities in Ohio since 1947. In Ohio and across our system, our core customers include local distribution companies, marketers and traders, natural gas producers, gas-fired electric generators, residential, commercial and industrial customers.

The shale resource plays in both the Marcellus and Utica formations in Ohio present an exciting outlook for natural gas development and related infrastructure demand in the coming years. The resulting opportunities will create economic prosperity for Ohioans in a region that has experienced high unemployment.

AEP Ohio's commitment to transform their generation fleet and substantially increase total annual natural gas volumes will directly and significantly support shale gas production and infrastructure in Ohio. Competitively priced long-term shale gas contracts - with producers who commit to investment and employment growth in the state - will allow Ohio to capture the economic benefits of its shale resource for the citizens of Ohio. This will lead to job growth in Ohio and reasonably priced electricity throughout the AEP Ohio service territory.
