Ms. Roberto,

I wanted to thank you again for your professional consideration at the September 8 public hearing on this issue. It is my understanding that there is a very important meeting in Columbus tomorrow where this issue may be decided. My position on this issue has not changed. There is no logical basis for a large Duke Generation surcharge on its customers (including customers who choose alternate energy suppliers).

If any provider of electricity chooses to invest to build future generation capacity it must be internally justified like any other company. That company asks 'does it make good financial sense to our company including the financial risk.' In this case the Public would be forced to fund the capacity investment. That leaves Duke with zero risk, lucrative future generation capacity, and negates the deregulation legislation passed by the State of Ohio which has saved Ohio families, businesses and our economy billions of dollars over the last few years.

After the hearing you asked me 'how could PUCO not approve the Duke proposal'? I still maintain that you let Duke compete with other companies as the State Legislature mandated. My understanding is we do not understand how Duke's estimate of the 2021 future power demand fits with the Federal projections. Nor do we understand what the scores of other electric providers in Ohio or the scores of other alternate suppliers in surrounding states plan to do regarding future capacity. I also think we do not understand the impact of future electric conservation efforts. How much capacity will be needed is a very important macro coordination issue that must be addressed but using public funds to enable one electric company to build capacity is not the answer and will drive most of the alternate suppliers out of business. Based on pre-deregulation history the rates will then skyrocket since there will be little incentive for the remaining few suppliers to manage costs.

While I applaud Duke's contributions to the community and the professionalism of its workforce, I have significant concerns whether Duke is structured to provide electricity to its customers at a competitive cost. Many of my issues are on the September 8 public record. Please contact me if you would like to discuss further.
