ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On September 7, 2011, the Commission issued its Second Opinion and Order in this proceeding. In that entry, the Commission determined that sufficient evidence had been presented to support the continuation of the previously approved December 2, 2009 stipulation. That stipulation provided for Columbia to transition from a Standard Service Offer to a Standard Choice Offer (SCO) beginning April 1, 2012. Columbia was directed to file revised tariffs consistent with that order to implement the SCO.
- (3) On October 14, 2011, Columbia filed tariffs in compliance with the September 7, 2011 order. The Commission has reviewed those tariffs and finds them to be reasonable and consistent with the Commission's entry and, therefore, the tariffs should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the tariffs filed by Columbia, as described above, are approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Columbia is authorized to file four complete copies of tariffs in final form, consistent with this entry. Columbia shall file one copy in this case docket and one copy in its TRF docket (or may file electronically as directed in Case No 06-900-AU-WVR). The remaining two copies shall be designated for distribution to the Rates and Tariffs, Energy and Water Division of the Commission's Utilities Department. It is, further,
