**NOTICE OF THE DAYTON POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY TO
WITHDRAW ITS EMISSION FEE RIDER APPLICATION**

The Dayton Power and Light Company (“DP&L” or “the Company”) hereby provides notice of withdraw for its Application of Continued Recovery of Emission Fees pursuant to Finding and Order dated November 9, 2011 in Case No. 09-1012-EL-FAC.

On March 2, 2009 DP&L filed to collect additional emission fee costs from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency that the Company incurred. No order on the application has been issued. The emission fee costs in the pending application are now included for recovery in the Company’s Fuel Rider, as stipulated in Case No. 09-1012-EL-FAC.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reason, DP&L respectfully provides notice to withdraw for its Application of Continued Recovery of Emission Fees, and to cancel Distribution Tariff D29.
