ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On October 14, 2009, Reflective Energy Solutions, LLC (Reflective Energy or company) filed applications for certification as a retail electric and natural gas aggregator/broker. The Commission granted the applications, issuing Certificate Nos. 09-176E(1) and 09-166(G)(1), effective November 14, 2009 through November 14, 2011.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that a government aggregator/broker is required to file an application for renewal of its certificate at least 30 days prior to the expiration date of its current certificate.
- (3) On November 4, 2011, Reflective Energy filed applications to renew its certification.
- (4) On November 14, 2011, Reflective Energy filed motions for an extension of its certificates' expiration date. In its motions, Reflective Energy stated that, due to an inadvertent administrative error, the company filed its renewal applications on November 4, 2011, approximately 21 days after the October 14, 2011, deadline. Further, Reflective Energy stated that the company will take steps to ensure that this administrative oversight does not recur.
- (5) Accordingly, in order to provide the Commission sufficient time to review the applications for renewal, Reflective Energy requested that its current certificates be extended to December 5, 2011.
- (6) The attorney examiner finds that Reflective Energy's motions for extension of its certificates to December 5, 2011, are reasonable and should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with finding (6), Reflective Energy's motions for an extension of its certificates' expiration dates be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the November 14, 2011, expiration date of Certificate Nos. 09-176E(1) and 09-166(G)(1) be extended to December 5, 2011. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
