ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Lyden Oil Company (Lyden), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code, alleging that Lyden was in violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) A hearing was initially scheduled for November 17, 2011, but was continued to December 15, 2011, at the request of staff.
- (3) On December 9, 2011, staff filed a motion for a continuance of the December 15, 2011 hearing. Staff stated that Lyden indicated it has a conflict with the December 15, 2011 hearing date and that it requested that the hearing be continued. Staff noted that it does not object to a continuance. Both parties indicated that the hearing should be continued to January 10, 2012.
- (4) Upon review, the attorney examiner finds good cause to continue the hearing. Accordingly, the December 15, 2011 hearing should be continued to January 10, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 1247, 12th Floor, at the offices of the Commission 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,




