ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) By opinion and order issued December 17, 2008, in *In the Matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., for Approval of an Electric Security Plan,* Case No. 08-920-EL-SSO, et al., the Commission approved a stipulation submitted by Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) and other parties in that case. The stipulation, as approved, provides that Duke may submit a request annually for the recovery of net incremental costs or credits associated with environmental compliance, homeland security, and changes in tax law included in the price-to-compare, annually adjusted component rider (Rider PTC-AAC). The stipulation states that such request will be subject to due process and the opportunity for hearing.
- (2) On September 1, 2011, Duke filed an application to establish a new price for Rider PTC-AAC, along with testimony supporting the application.
- (3) By entry issued October 26, 2011, the attorney examiner granted a motion to extend the procedural schedule in this case based on the parties' explanation that, if the stipulation filed on October 24, 2011, in Case Nos. 11-3549-EL-SSO, 11-3550-EL-ATA, and 11-3551-EL-UNC (11-3549, et al.) was approved by the Commission, it would render this case unnecessary.
- (4) On November 23, 2011, Duke filed a request to withdraw its application in this case due to the Commission's November 22, 2011, approval of the October 24, 2011, stipulation in 11-3549, et al. Upon consideration of Duke's request, we find that the instant case should be dismissed and closed of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Duke's request to withdraw this case be granted and Case No. 11-4916-EL-RDR be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
