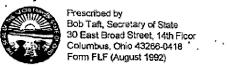

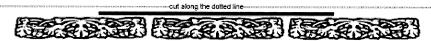

In 2007, LSSi Corp. was acquired by Volt Delta Resources, LLC ("Volt Delta"), and is a wholly owned subsidiary of Volt Delta.² Volt Delta is a wholly owned subsidiary of Volt Information Sciences, Inc. ("VIS"). VIS is a publicly traded company that provides workforce consulting, technology management consulting, and database services. Information concerning LSSi Data Corp.'s financial viability comes by way of the parent company, VIS.

VIS is currently going through an accounting review and planned restatement of prior issued financial statements, which has caused a delay in the filing of the VIS's Form 10-K with the Securities Exchange Commission ("SEC"). An updated financial statement cannot be provided until the restatement is submitted with the SEC. The attached press release provides the Company's most recent update.

Volt Information Sciences Provides Update on Third Quarter Business Performance

New York, NY, November 2, 2011 – Volt Information Sciences, Inc. (OTC: VISI) today provided a business update and reported selected unaudited financial information for its fiscal 2011 third quarter ended July 31, 2011. The Company noted that, due to a previously announced accounting review, all numbers presented in this release are estimates.

Steven Shaw, Volt's President and Chief Executive Officer, stated, "The Staffing Services Segment, which accounts for a majority of the Company's total revenue, had approximately \$460 million of revenue in the fiscal third quarter 2011 compared to approximately \$425 million for the same period in 2010. Staffing Services revenue increased approximately 8% for the quarter, and approximately 14% year-to-date, compared to the prior year. On average, approximately 31,400 U.S. staffing employees were on assignment in the quarter, compared to approximately 30,200 in the third quarter of 2010."

While the Telecommunications Services and the Printing and Other Segments together sustained a small loss in the third quarter of 2011, these segments showed an improvement over the prior year's third quarter. Results for the Computer Systems Segment will be reported after the accounting review is completed.

Liquidity

During the nine-month period the Company disbursed approximately \$37 million in connection with the restatement and related investigations costs and approximately \$12 million for net capital expenditures, while cash of approximately \$5 million was provided by all other operating activities. The Company transferred approximately \$5 million during this period to restricted cash as collateral for new European banking facilities and cash and cash equivalents decreased by approximately an additional \$13 million. Borrowings under the accounts receivable securitization program increased by approximately \$30 million.

On July 31, 2011, the Company had cash and cash equivalents of approximately \$33 million and an additional approximately \$35 million of cash set aside as collateral for foreign currency credit lines and banking facilities. The Company also had approximately \$70 million available from its accounts receivable securitization program. The Company's consolidated borrowings were approximately \$102 million at July 31, 2011, which includes approximately \$22 million of foreign currency borrowings primarily used to hedge foreign denominated receivables and fully collaterized by restricted cash, and approximately \$80 million drawn under the \$150 million securitization program. The approximately \$80 million drawn under the securitization program was increased to approximately \$90 million in September 2011.

The Company believes that it has more than ample liquidity to meet its business requirements currently and for the foreseeable future.

LSSi Data Corp. is currently certificated and has been certificated as a CLEC in Minnesota, Oregon, Utah and Washington since 2005, and as an IXC in Illinois since 1999. Although LSSi Data does not currently provide its proposed service to any customers in any jurisdiction, LSSi Data plans to introduce such services.

LSSi Data was previously certified by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") to operate as an interexchange carrier (Certificate No. 90-5882). This certification was cancelled under a November 22, 2010 Entry in Case No. 10-05-TP-RPT due to a delay in the Company's filing of an Annual Report for 2009. This regrettable delay was caused by significant, unplanned personnel changes within the department responsible for management of LSSi Data's compliance filings with the Commission and other governmental agencies. Although LSSi Data did file its 2009 Annual Report in December 2010, the de-certification process had at that point already proceeded.

Thereafter, upon consultation among LSSi Data's outside regulatory counsel and the Commission's Telecom Section Chief in May of 2010 concerning the possibility of reinstatement, and in consideration of LSSi Data's plan to roll-out the proposed service discussed above, it was determined that a new application for CLEC certification was the more advisable course. LSSi Data now respectfully seeks certification as a CLEC. Attached are the company's 2010 Annual Report and most recent Telephone Relay Service Report Forms.

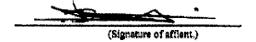
