The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) By finding and order issued December 14, 2011, in order to implement Section 749.10 of Amended Substitute House Bill 153, the Commission, *inter alia*, determined that, by December 22, 2011, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) should:
 - file a list in this docket containing the names of the wireless service providers that will pay a lesser amount in assessments for fiscal year 2012 to OCC;
 - (b) submit to the Commission's Director of the Utilities Department the requisite information, including the breakdown of the decrease in OCC's assessment attributable to each wireless service provider;
 - (c) issue notification to each wireless service provider regarding the amount of the decrease in the provider's OCC assessment; and
 - (d) file any necessary corrections to the attachment to OCC's November 4, 2011, filing.
- (2) On December 21, 2011, OCC filed a motion for extension of time and for an expedited ruling, requesting that the December 22, 2011, filing deadline be extended to January 5, 2012. In support of its motion, OCC states that additional time is needed to prepare the requested information and comply with the Commission's other requests in the December 14, 2011, order. OCC submits that, since there are no parties in this case, there is no one to contact with regard to the request for an expedited ruling.

(3) Upon consideration of OCC's motion for extension and expedited ruling, the attorney examiner finds that it is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, OCC shall have until January 5, 2012, to provide the information required pursuant to the December 14, 2011, order.

ORDERED, That OCC's motion for extension and expedited ruling be granted, and OCC shall provide the information required pursuant to the December 14, 2011, order by January 5, 2012. It is, further,
