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**MOTION TO AMEND JOINT APPLICATION**

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Pursuant to O.A.C. 4901-1-06, The Ohio Edison Company ("Ohio Edison") moves to amend its Joint Application ("Application") with Republic Engineered Products, Inc. ("Republic") by filing the attached revised Exhibit 2 to the Application. As demonstrated in its Memorandum in Support, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, Ohio Edison wishes to amend the Application and Exhibit 2 to request commitment payments and cash rebates for Republic's five energy efficiency projects rather than an exemption from payment of the electric utility's energy efficiency/peak demand reduction rider.

On November 25, 2009, Ohio Edison Company (“Ohio Edison”) and Republic Engineered Products, Inc. (“Republic”) (collectively the “Applicants”) filed an application for approval of a special arrangement agreement (“Application”) in the above-referenced matter. On March 29, 2010, the Applicants amended the Application. The Application requested an exemption from payment of the electric utility’s energy efficiency/peak demand reduction rider for five projects implemented by Republic.

O.A.C. 4901-1-06 states that “the commission ... may ... upon motion of any party for good cause shown, authorize the amendment of any application, complaint, long-term forecast report, or other pleading filed with the commission.”

For the reasons stated above, good cause exists for the Commission to allow Ohio Edison to file an amended version of the Application, which makes the following change:

- Requesting a commitment payment for the three projects that do not qualify for an incentive instead of an exemption from payment of the energy efficiency/peak demand reduction rider, and
- Requesting a cash rebate for the remaining two projects instead of an exemption from payment of the energy efficiency/peak demand reduction rider.

(2) The eligible rebate amount is based upon 75% of the rebates offered by the FirstEnergy Commercial and Industrial Energy Efficiency programs or 75% of \$0.08/kWh for custom programs for all energy savings eligible for a cash rebate as defined in the PUCO order in Case NO.10-834-EL-EEC dated 9/15/2010, not to exceed the lesser of 50% of the project cost or \$250,000 per project. The rebate also cannot exceed \$500,000 per customer per year, per utility service territory.
