ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On October 5, 2011, Hospital Energy Services LLC (Hospital Energy or company) filed a motion for a protective order (MPO), pursuant to Rule 4901-1-24(D), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), requesting that exhibit C-5 of its application for certification as a competitive retail natural gas aggregator be kept under seal. Subsequently, on November 1 and 7, 2011, Hospital Energy filed other exhibits of its application, C-3 and C-7, which appear to be included in the request for confidential treatment.
- (2) The MPO submitted in this matter was signed by Hospital Energy's president, an attorney licensed in the state of Connecticut.
- (3) By entry dated December 19, 2011, Hospital Energy was advised that, in order for the company's October 5, 2011, MPO to be considered, it must be signed by an Ohio attorney or submitted by an out-of-state attorney appearing *pro hac vice*. Hospital Energy also was advised that, if the company wished to continue to pursue its MPO, a properly-filed MPO must be filed in this docket by January 13, 2012. Further, failure to submit a properly-filed MPO in the time provided would result in the placement of Hospital Energy's exhibits C-3, C-5, and C-7 in the open record.
- (4) To date, a properly-filed MPO has not been submitted in this docket. Therefore, the attorney examiner directs the Commission's docketing division to release exhibits C-3, C-5, and C-7, filed under seal in this docket on October 5, 2011, and November 1 and 7, 2011, into the public record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the Commission's docketing division release into the public record exhibits C-3, C-5, and C-7, filed under seal in this docket on October 5, 2011, and November 1 and 7, 2011. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon on Hospital Energy and all interested persons of record.
