





ERRATA TO STIPULATION AND RECOMMENDATION

On December 28, 2011, Eastern Natural Gas Company ("Eastern"), Pike Natural Gas Company ("Pike"), and Southeastern Natural Gas Company ("Southeastern") or, collectively, the "Companies" and the Staff (collectively, the "Signatory Parties") filed a Stipulation and Recommendation ("Stipulation") before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") to resolve all issues in the above referenced cases. On page four of the Stipulation, paragraph 3 inadvertently references "Pike" rather than

"Southeastern." The error has been corrected as shown on the following errata pages.

Further, Staff of the Commission has been made aware of the error and concurs with the attached corrections.

a. Hillsboro Division

Pike will decrease the Hillsboro GCR by \$28,090 to represent the net difference between the Staff's and Pike's AA calculations.

Pike will increase the Hillsboro GCR by \$136 to reflect the net differences between the Staff's and Pike's calculations of the Reconciliation Adjustment ("RA").

Pike will also increase the Hillsboro GCR by \$303 to reflect the net difference between the Staff's and Pike's calculation of the BA.

These adjustments will be applied in the first GCR filing following the Opinion and Order in this case.

b. Waverly Division

Pike will decrease the Waverly GCR by \$34,071 to represent the net difference between the Staff's and Pike's AA calculations.

These adjustments will be applied in the first GCR filing following the Opinion and Order in this case.

3. Southeastern Natural Gas Company (Case No. 11-215-GA-GCR)

Southeastern will decrease the GCR by \$21,120 to represent the net difference between the Staff's and Pike's Southeastern's AA calculations.

Pike Southeastern will also increase the Hillsboro GCR by \$31,329 to reflect the net difference between the Staff's and Pike's Southeastern's calculation of the BA.
