Dear Our company was stunned by the rate increase from AEP for the distribution charges on our most recent electric bill. We are a small manufacturing business that converts wastepaper into insulation and for use as additives in roof coatings, parking lot sealants, asphalt paving, structural steel fireproofing, rubber composites, etc. Our total electrical consumption over the last 12 months was 4,059,000 KWH.

Our tariff is 841, Medium General Service. On our 19 December 2011 bill, our metered usage was 331,800 KWH and 1,027.8 KW and the Distribution Service component was \$5,549.25. On our 23 January 2011 bill, our metered usage was 282,600 KWH and 1,029.0 KW and the Distribution Service component was \$13,546.21.

There is no clarity (none) related to how AEP calculates the Distribution Service charge. Simply a \$ amount listed beside the Distribution Service line. I assume it is based upon KWH usage but no detail is provided on how this is calculated. Assuming it is based upon KWH usage, the KWH unit rate went from \$0.0162 to \$0.0479 or 2.95X greater.

I understand this price increase has been temporarily put on hold however I am greatly concerned that the PUCO will relent. We are a small business with 22 employees and under the current economic conditions have been struggling as have many small businesses. We are unable to pass along a price hit of this magnitude to our customers. If copies of our invoices would be of benefit or our presence at a hearing, we are willing to participate.
