ENTRY NUNC PRO TUNC

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 7, 2012, the Commission issued an opinion and order approving the request made by Oak Hill Union Local Schools, pursuant to Section 4511.63, Revised Code, for an exemption for school buses from stopping at 22 grade crossings within the village of Oak Hill, as well as within Jefferson Township and Madison Township, located in Jackson County, Ohio.
- (2) The last sentence in the fourth paragraph on page 4 of the opinion and order incorrectly states: "Accordingly, ODOT should place signs marked 'Exempt' that are in conformance with the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices at the crossings and at other appropriate locations in advance of the crossings." This sentence should be corrected nunc pro tunc to state: "Accordingly, ODOT, Jackson County, village of Oak Hill, Madison Township, and Jefferson Township, as appropriate, should place signs marked 'Exempt' that are in conformance with the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices at the crossings and at other appropriate locations in advance of the crossings." In all other respects, the March 7, 2012, opinion and order shall remain unchanged.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the March 7, 2012, opinion and order be corrected nunc pro tunc, in accordance with finding (2). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


