The PUCO's mission is "to assure all residential and business consumers access to adequate, safe and reliable utility services at fair prices, while facilitating an environment that provides competitive choice." How is fair that large industrial electric users should supplement smaller

businesses, churches, schools and residential customers? The fair approach would be that everyone, no matter the size, should pay for the amount of electricity that they use and they should pay for their fair share of the cost to produce and deliver that electricity. If the consumer does not like their electricity bill then they should find ways to reduce their use of electricity. How does the PUCO facilitate an environment that provides competitive choice when they force AEP to have an extremely low per megawatt-day charge, thus allowing other utilities to cherry-pick AEP's customers and put AEP in a position where there is nothing that AEP can do about it. That is not competitive that is a recipe for monopoly which is the exact opposite of a competitive market. The PUCO needs to evaluate their mission statement and their purpose if they are going to continue to make hasty, radical decisions that affect all consumers and the utilities that they represent.

The PUCO states that their mission is accomplished in a list of ways of which the following are two of those ways: "ensuring financial integrity and service reliability in the Ohio utility industry" and "monitoring and enforcing compliance with rules and statutory protections against deceptive, unfair, unsafe and anti-competitive utility practices". What the PUCO did and what the PUCO states their mission is and how it is achieved are two totally different things.

With this being said, I feel that the PUCO was out of line with their decision made on February 23rd to throw out AEP's rate plan that had already been approved by the PUCO. This was not a rate plan that was all one sided for AEP, it was a rate plan that had been heavily negotiated by AEP, the PUCO and multiple companies and groups for months. This very rate plan, the negotiated rate plan, was approved by the PUCO in December. The chairman of the PUCO, Todd Snitchler, stated "We need to revisit our decision to make sure we get it right". My questions for Todd and the PUCO are: What were all of you doing during 2011 when AEP was going through their proposed rate plan? What were you doing during all of the negotiations that took place? And Why would you approve a rate plan if you were not sure it was right and fair to begin with? While the PUCO may think that their decision was in the best interest of the consumer, they are wrong, as a competitive electricity marketplace in Ohio requires many strong electricity providers, all that the PUCO has done is put AEP at a disadvantage in the market place by eliminating competitive utility practices. While I do not like to see my electricity bill increase, I do understand that the costs for AEP to produce electricity has increased and thus the reason for AEP to request relief. One cannot expect AEP to absorb all of the increase, as basic economics will tell you that a business that is unable to make a profit will not be a business very long. AEP needs to be able to pass their cost (and a fair rate of return on their investments) onto the consumers who use the electricity that AEP provides. If AEP were to leave Ohio and sell their Ohio assets to a competitor the rates in Ohio would increase by a lot more than what the AEP rates would have ever been.

The PUCO needs to reinstate AEP's rate plan as approved previously and allow AEP to continue to provide its customers with affordable and reliable electricity.

power plants to serve our customers and avoided implementing higher market rates. That commitment cannot be changed overnight and will last three years into the future.

Now competitors, most of whom don't have investments in Ohio and many who own no assets at all, want to use AEP Ohio's plants to serve customers using an arbitrary price as a basis for paying for the use of those plants. Since the passage of SB3, the policy of the state of Ohio has been to encourage competitive service for electric generation for consumers.

At the initiations of 'deregulation', AEP Ohio rates were substantially below 'market' prices -wholesale market prices that could be secured for serving retail customers through a CRES
provider. During this time, AEP Ohio could have sought to 'flash-cut' to selling their generation
at market rates, maximizing their profits at the expense of their customers that would be left to
find the best possible prices from the market. However, negotiating in good faith with the PUCO
and customer groups, AEP Ohio sought to find a compromise solution that would allow it to
make a fair rate of return on its generation, while still offering attractive rates for customers.
AEP Ohio 'did the right thing' by working cooperatively to find win-win outcomes for all
involved.

Recent developments have cause market prices to fall below those able to be offered by AEP Ohio. Substantial efforts were made by the Company to work with the PUCO staff and a wide range of stakeholders to find a reasonable compromise through an orderly transition timeframe. The impacts of such changes were to be difficult for AEP Ohio, yet manageable. The PUCO agreed with such compromise. Then abruptly changed its decision, bowing to public and political pressure. And to further exacerbate the issue, some unyielding parties now want to 'flash cut' to market rates, with AEP Ohio capacity being used to serve customers.

The situation is untenable for AEP Ohio. With the current impacts of the decision, AEP Ohio would make dramatic reductions in employment and investment in the State. And the level of risk introduced to utility operations in the State by this decision is already spooking the financial markets, that will ultimately lead to further increases in financing costs, which will ultimately by borne by customers. The many statements of shock by market analysts characterizing the recent PUCO decision have been spot-on.

I am requesting that the PUCO consider the conditions under which it is making its decisions in the above cases, and simply 'do the right thing' by finding a compromise situation that can be a win-win outcome for the parties involved. While short-term thinking may be politically expedient, the Commission has the responsibility to ensure that its decisions are deliberate, fair to all parties, and in the best long-term interests of the public.
